


### WINTER NEWSLETTER

#### **New Beginnings Homes Dictionary**

We know some terms in our newsletters may be unfamiliar, so we've created this quick guide to help you navigate NBH lingo! If there's a term or phrase you'd like us to add, let us know!

YWAM - Youth with a Mission (our umbrella organization). Learn more about YWAM at www.ywam.org.

Birth Mother - A loving mother who has chosen to place her child with a forever family through adoption.

**AfterCare** – A program for moms (birth moms or parenting moms) who choose to continue living at NBH after the birth of their child. Both programs offer housing and support for up to 18 months post-birth.

- House of Hope is the program for parenting moms.
- House of Blessings is the program for birth moms.

**After-AfterCare** – Our extended housing program, designed for moms who have completed an AfterCare program and wish to remain part of the NBH community long-term. This affordable housing option currently serves two moms. We hope to expand by adding more tiny homes to support even more families.
